SCHOOL COMMITTEE LEGAL STATUS

The School Committee is the governing board of the Chicopee Public Schools. Although it functions as a duly elected committee of the city government, it owes its existence to the Massachusetts General Laws, which decree that each public school system will be governed by a school committee to carry out the educational policies of the state and guide the educational process.

The School Committee possesses all powers and duties conferred upon it by state law. Certain legislative powers are also granted to the Committee by the city charter and code. The Committee alone may determine policies and practices and employ a Superintendent who shall employ a staff to implement its direction and policies for the proper education of the children of the City of Chicopee.
