## SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

A summer school program of study will be offered to the residents of Chicopee and surrounding communities for the purpose of:

1. Making up credit loss
2. Improvement of skills
3. Enrichment

### General Guidelines for Summer School

1. Tuition shall be determined on an annual basis with out-of-district students paying a higher rate than residents of Chicopee.
2. The disciplinary code of summer school will not differ from the regular school year. Serious violation of the disciplinary code may result in dismissal without refund.
3. Transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the individual student.

### Courses Taken to Earn Credit

1. Enrollment and credit for a summer school course taken in Chicopee or in a neighboring community must receive the prior approval of the student's principal.
2. Students must have been enrolled for an entire course and achieved a course average of 50 during the regular school year to enroll in summer school courses.
3. Students who have been denied credits for excessive absences and have received a passing grade in a particular course will be eligible to enroll in a summer school course.
4. Course of study will follow the approved curriculum of regular day school.
5. Students must complete established requirements for a given summer school course to receive credit:
  - tests/exams
  - homework
  - no more than two absences (one absence for 2.5 credit course)
  - final exam (required)
6. Students who take summer school courses outside of Chicopee must fulfill the same requirements as Chicopee.
