STUDENT FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The following regulations will apply when a Chicopee school is involved in a fund-raising activity:

1. Any school related activity must have prior approval of the principal.
 - a. The principal shall require a written request by the sponsor giving him the complete details of the fund-raising activity as well as the reasons and rationale behind it.
 - b. The principal shall use his discretion pertaining to publicity relative to the activity.
 - c. The principal shall require from the sponsor a complete financial report at the conclusion of the fund-raising activity.
2. When organizing fund-raising projects, emphasis should be placed on service-type projects where talents of students are used in positive, developmental ways.
3. When commercial products are involved, a reasonable profit commensurate with the time and effort involved should be expected. A reasonable amount of technical assistance from the firm involved should be expected. Agreements between firms supplying fund-raising products and student groups should be in writing.
4. Groups which organize and raise money must use such money for school-related functions or charitable organizations.
5. Fund raisers, for any school related activity in the future, will be prohibited from using any form of toll road/gate fundraiser.

In accordance with the District Wellness Policy (File: A8), all fund-raising projects within the school day are encouraged to follow the Mass Action for Healthy Kids Nutrition Standards.
